

Online Game Reporting for CBYSA

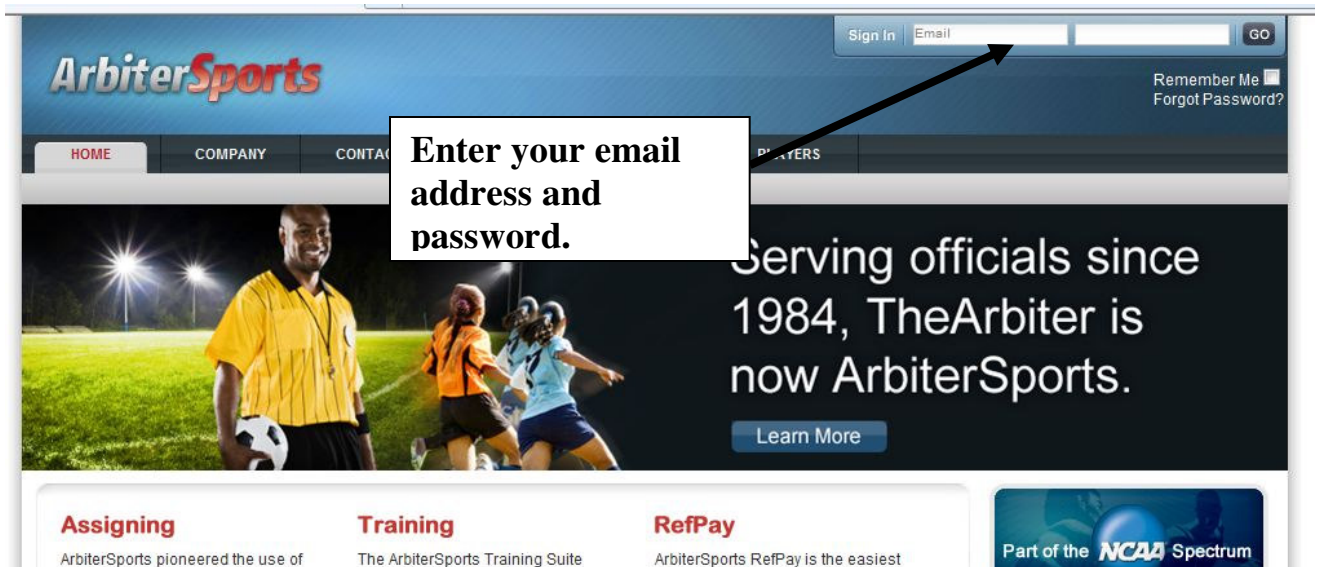
Beginning with the Spring 2009 season, CBYSA will no longer be using the blue cards by which coaches have in the past submitted their comments on referees and opposing teams. The process will now be done entirely online. By doing so, you will be able to get your comments quickly to someone who can act on your information, if needed. When you submit an online report, it will go to the Coaching Director, the Parent/Player Director, and to the Referee Director. In addition, this new process will save CBYSA approximately 1,200 dollars per year in printing costs.

The online report involves a two step process, the first of which starts with the Arbiter assigning system. The Arbiter automatically assigns a unique number to every game, and by using that number in your online report, you will help us identify the referee(s) who worked the game and confirm the teams who played the game. Although that game number is not absolutely required, you will save us time by providing it.

For the first step, we'll cover how you find your game schedule in Arbiter.

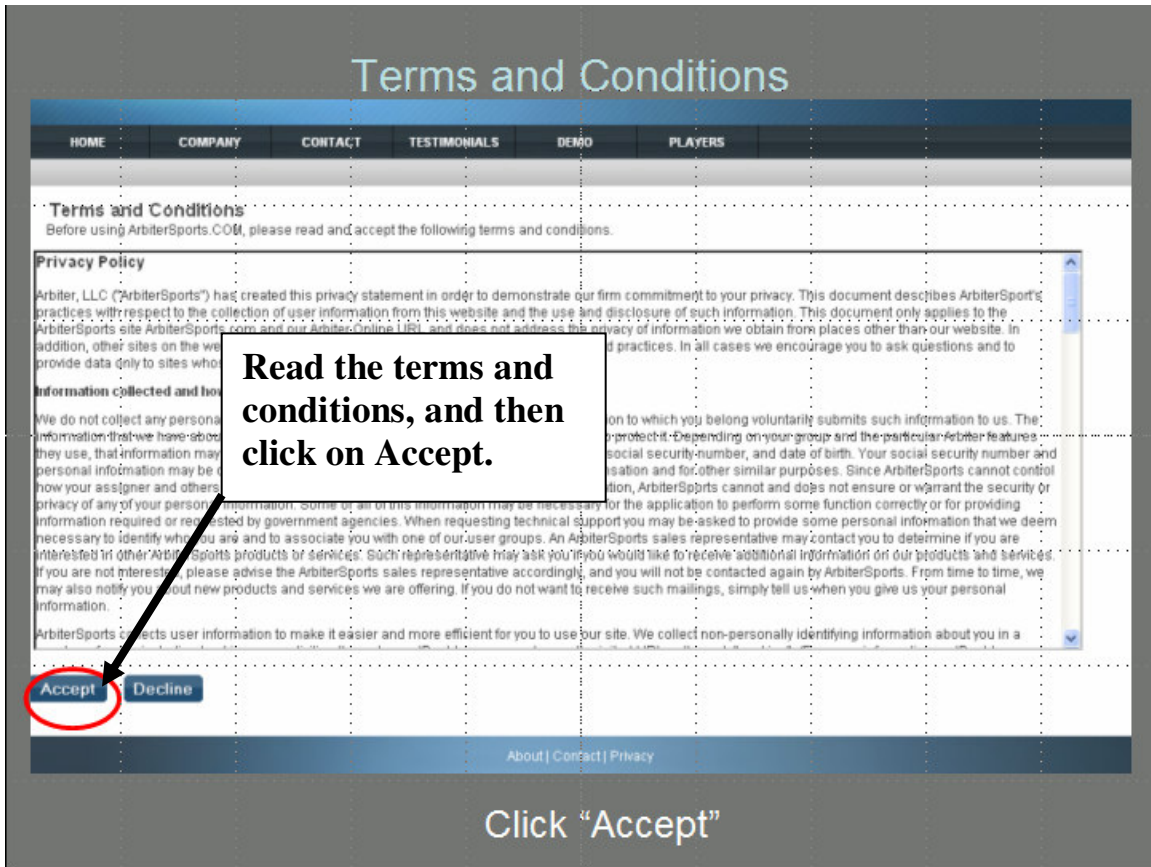
Working With Arbiter

If you have not yet signed in to Arbiter, you must go to www.arbitersports.com which will take you to the sign in page. It looks like this:

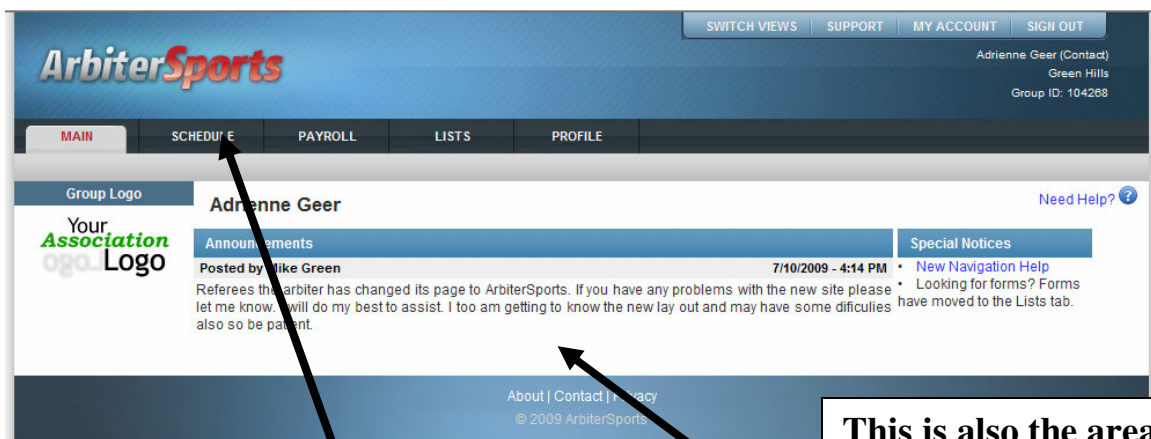


You must use the email address you provided when you registered your team with CBYSA. For your first time signing in, your password will be your last name.

The next page for your first time signing in will be the terms and conditions of usage of the Arbiter system.



Once you have accepted, you will be asked to change your password. Whenever you sign in to Arbiter at a later time, you will be taken directly to your Arbiter Start Page. To see your game schedule, find the Schedule tab, and then click on Schedule to go directly to your team's schedule.



The next page will show your team, or if you have more than one team, it will show all the teams you have registered with CBYSA. In this example, the coach had a winter futsal team and has an outdoor soccer team. Click on the number in the Games column to see your schedule for each of your teams.

Submitting a CBYSA Online Coach's Game Report

To find the online game report, go to the Coaches page of the CBYSA web site and scroll down to the bottom of the page. There you will see a link to the Coach's Game Report.



It is not required that you submit a report for every game. But if there are any exceptional issues in any game in which you participate, we would like to know. For example, if the referee does a good job, please let us know. Conversely, if you notice areas in which the referee needs to improve, we would like to know that too. We will use your inputs to help improve our referee program, and positive input is just as valuable as the input that lets us know improvements need to be made.

If there are any issues with the sportsmanship of the opposing team, its coaches, and its spectators, we would like to know that as well. We can work at correcting problems only when we are notified that such problems occur. You can be a big help in our goal to improve soccer for our youth.

When you have clicked on the link, this is what you will see.

Coach Game Report

Coaches: We are interested in your comments about CBYSA games, including the referee's performance and the sportsmanship of the opposing team. Please take a few minutes to answer the following questions. You do not have to answer all of them if you wish. However, **it is very important that you report the game number**. The more information you give us, the better we will be able to improve the soccer-playing environment.

Your game report will be sent automatically to the Referee Director, the Coaching Director, and the Parent/Player Director. If you would like a response from either, please make your request in the Comments box at the bottom of the form. After you have entered all your information, click the "Submit" button at the bottom of the form.
